Subj: Approval of Ships Whistles Under the 72 COLREGS

Your letter 1983#06#09 notified us of a modification to the valve unit for certain of your whistles and requested approval for these same modifications. Since none of the acoustical properties or installation requirements have changed, these devices, when installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, may continue to be used aboard U. S. Flag vessels as indicated below.
